

Rules of Conduct

The following are the rules of conduct to be followed by students at all Eastwood Church of Christ events and activities. Events and Activities of Eastwood Church of Christ Youth Ministry may include, but are not limited to the following: cookouts, swimming, laser tag, football, basketball, roller-skating, various games, soccer, volleyball, softball, baseball, camping, snowboarding, hiking, golfing, miniature golf, hayrides, Bible studies, summer camps, mission trips (domestic or international), other travel, and retreats. *Note: If you desire to limit your child's participation in any event, please submit your wishes in writing to the church youth minister prior to that event.*

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- No possession (or use) of alcohol, drugs, tobacco, or any offensive or inappropriate material is allowed at Eastwood Church of Christ youth events.
- No fighting, weapons, knives, fireworks, lighters, explosives, or other dangerous materials are allowed at Eastwood Church of Christ youth events.
- Foul language will not be tolerated at youth events. We are Christians and we should act as Christians. James 1:26; James 3:1-12; Ephesians 4:29
- No offensive or immodest clothing: (this is at the discretion of the youth minister, staff, and volunteers of Eastwood Church of Christ) 1 Timothy 2:9-10; 1 Peter 2:12; Romans 14:13-21
 - o Shorts must be fingertip length or longer
 - o No spaghetti straps, tank tops, or midriff shirts
 - o Jeans with holes may not have holes higher than the fingertips
 - o No cuss words or explicit graphics are allowed on apparel
- No Public Display of Affection is allowed at youth events unless you have the proper license (Marriage License). God calls us to live pure lives. This includes having self control in relationships with people of the opposite sex. Don't make me have a "talk" with you. I promise to embarrass you.
- If you come to an event, you must stay for the duration of the event unless prior notification is given to the youth minister by the parent/guardian or if a parent/guardian comes to pick you up prior to the end of the event. A lot of time, effort and money have gone into these events and they are done for you. Please respect the people who do them for you.
- Participation with the group is required at all events. If you come, you come to be involved with the given event.
- Respect any and all property being used by Eastwood Church of Christ. You break it, you buy it.
- Respect the people involved with any events done by Eastwood Church of Christ. This includes other students, staff and volunteers of these events.
- Respect the schedules of events. Try not to be late and respect those around you.
- DO NOT text or use cell phones during any serious events such as bible studies and devotionals. There will be plenty of time to text your friends after the event is over. You may text all you want during non-serious events such as games and free time on retreats, as long as you are actively participating in the event. Failure to follow this rule will result in you cell phone being taken away for the duration of the event.
